

The special board meeting that was approved at the October 10 regular meeting was held on Wednesday, October 19. The meeting was held in the library at Nemaha Central High School beginning at 5:00 PM.

Supt. Kohlman led the group on a tour throughout the high school facility. Several observations were made as to the proposed renovations recommended by architects with HTK Architects. The tour ended at 6:15.

The group returned to the library and members discussed the renovations as well as other projects which had been discussed in the recent past including a mobile phone app, Weatherbug System, technology and the addition to the bus barn. The members had previously postponed action on the bus barn bid that was presented at the October regular meeting. A history of revenues and expenditures in the Capital Outlay fund since consolidation was reviewed. After contemplation of the projects and funding of the projects, it was the consensus of the members to take more time for consideration before making a decision on any major expenses or improvements.
